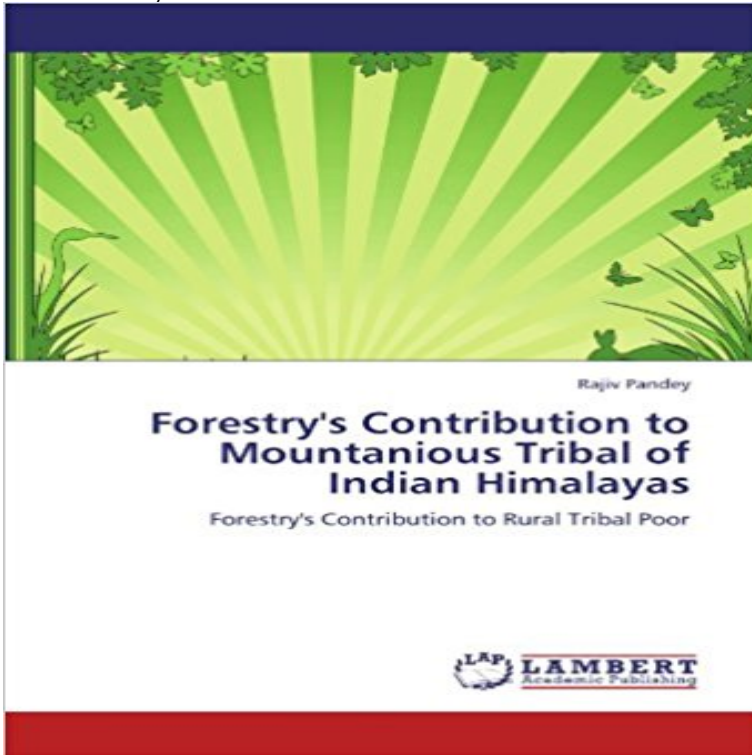


# Forestrys Contribution to Mountanious Tribal of Indian Himalayas: Forestrys Contribution to Rural Tribal Poor



The first chapter discusses about the forestrys contribution and poor. Chapter four builds on the theory to generate a set of operational hypotheses about the forestrys contribution and linkages with household attributes. Chapter five appraises the quality of life of the community and examines the relationships between household characteristics and forestrys contribution. The sixth chapter focuses on gender role and inequality with special refrence to forest collection. Chapter seven contains proposed indices for measure of forestrys contribution. The final chapter summaries the results and sets these findings within the content of public policies that influences forest management and conservation.
