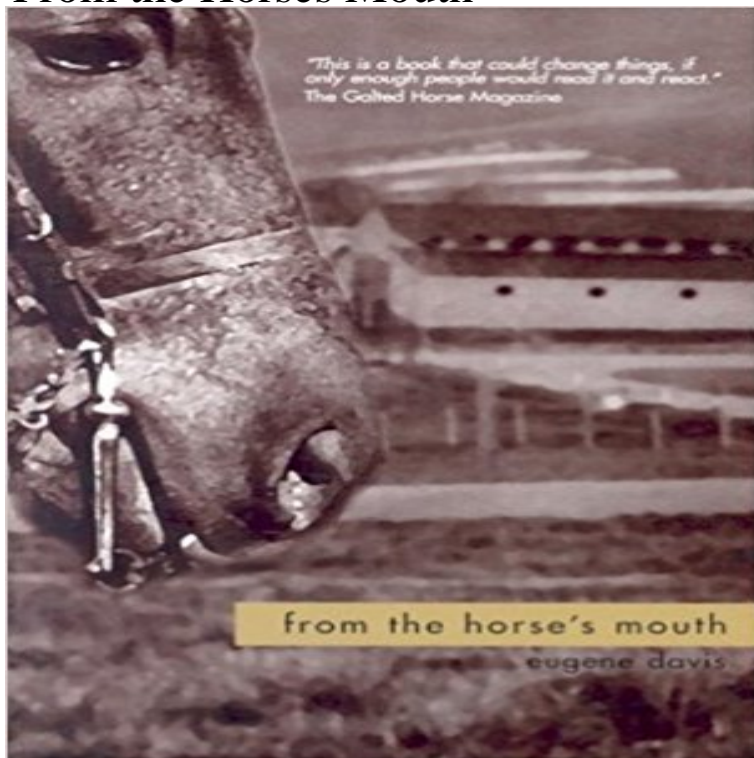


From the Horses Mouth
