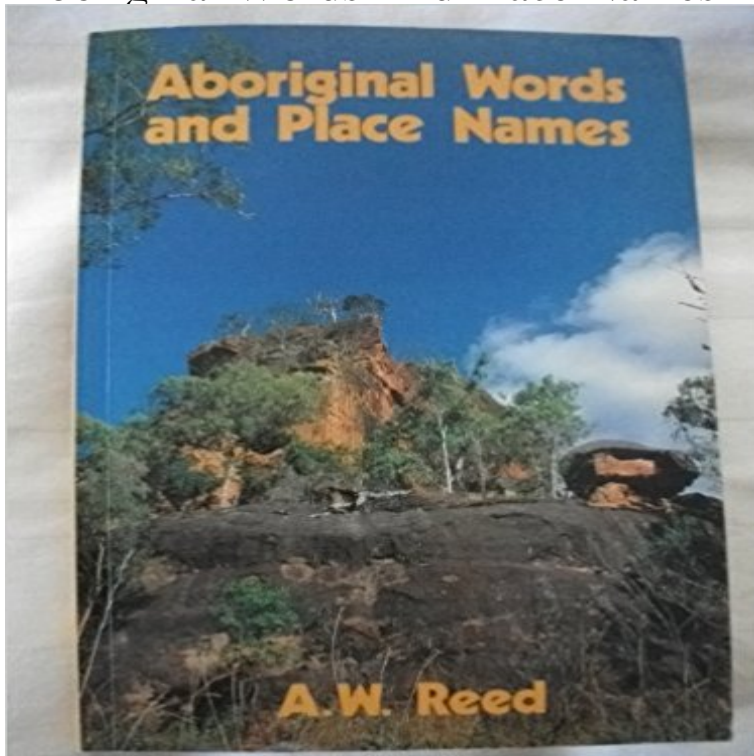


Aboriginal Words And Place Names
