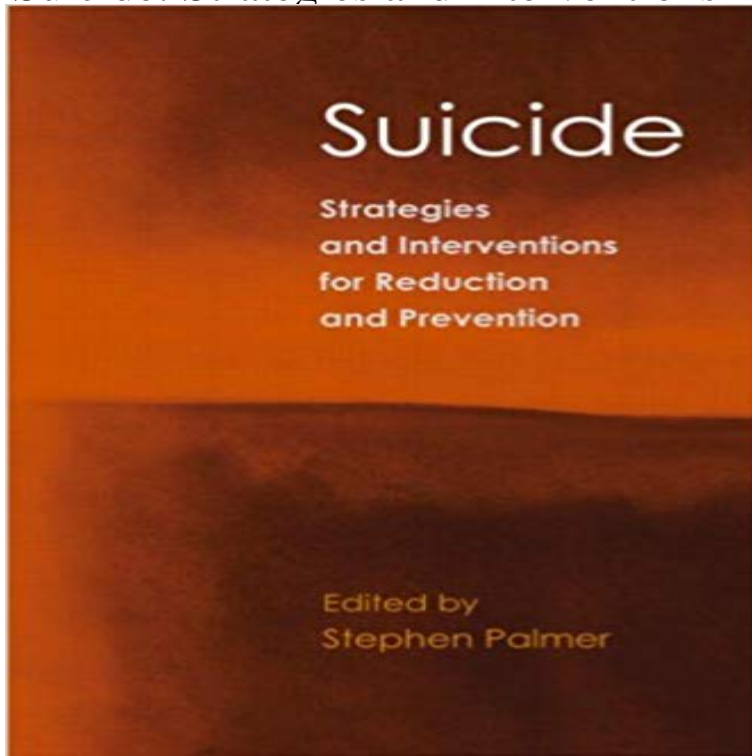


Suicide: Strategies and Interventions for Reduction and Prevention
