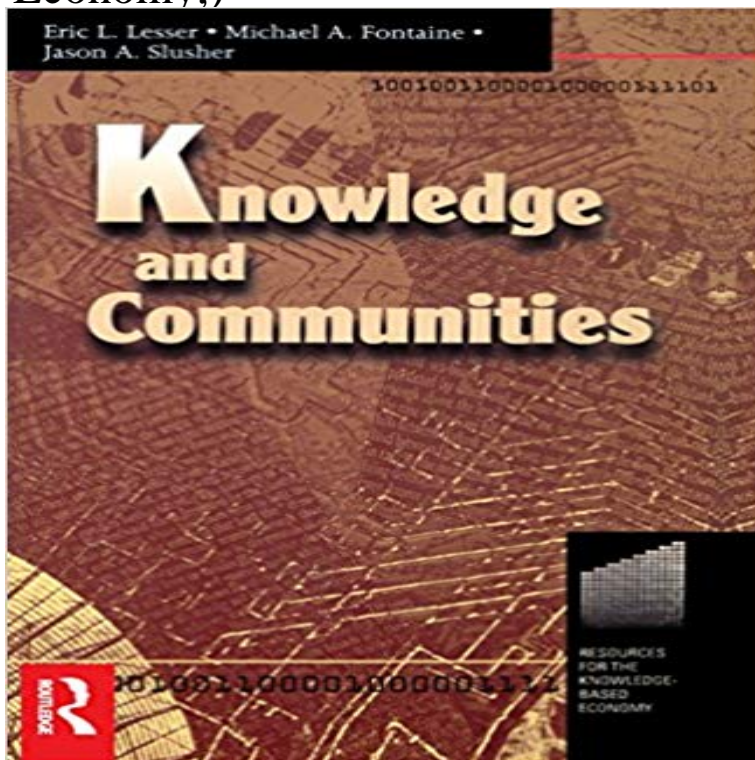


Knowledge and Communities (Resources for the Knowledge-Based Economy,)
