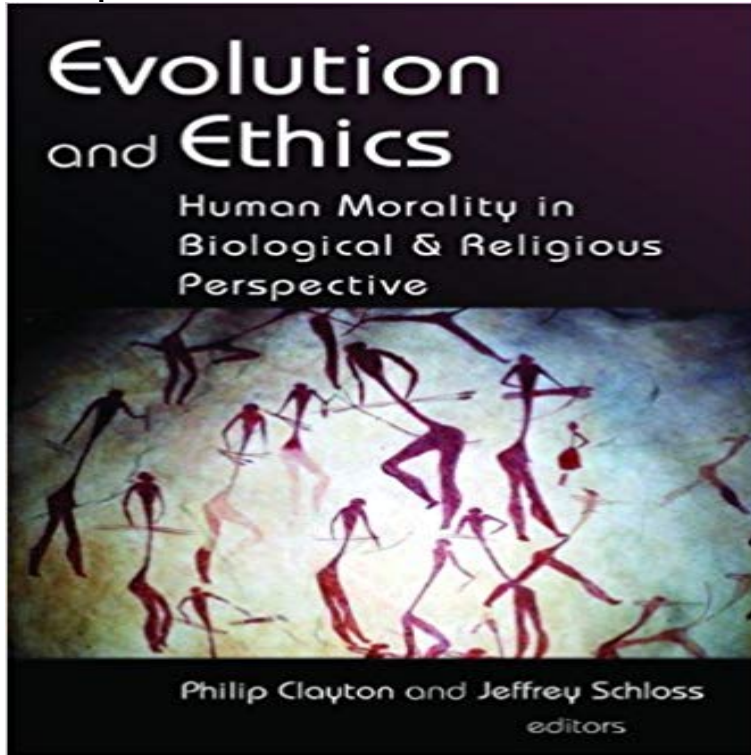


Evolution and Ethics: Human Morality in Biological and Religious Perspective
