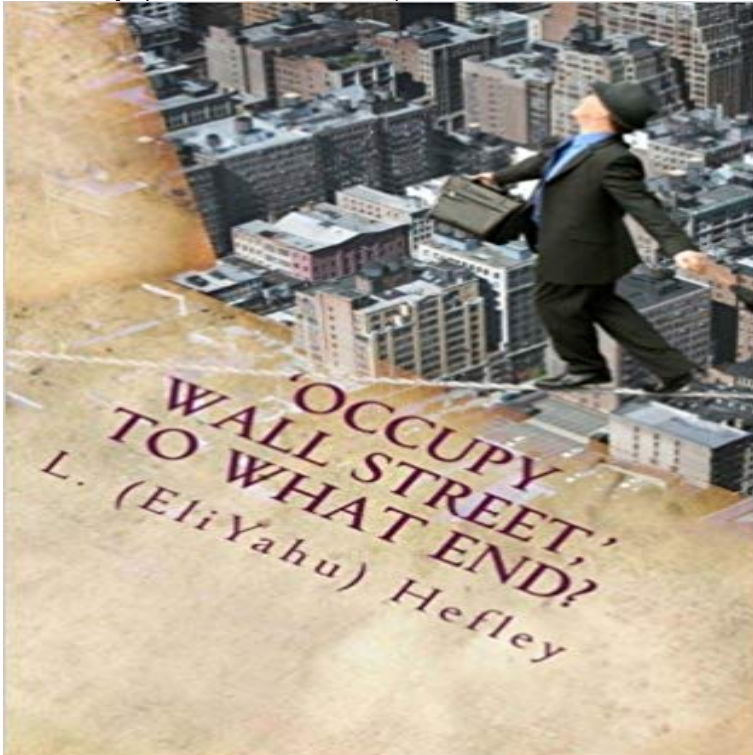


Occupy Wall Street, To What End?
