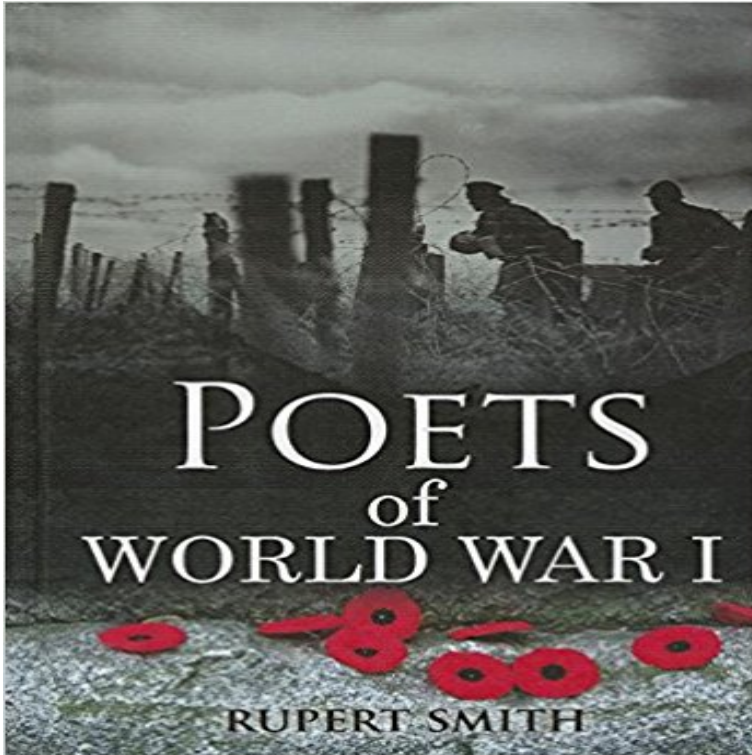


Poets of World War I
